Centurions bringing Woodstock to Tucson

TUCSON (AP) — The 50th anniversary of Woodstock is coming to Tucson, thanks to the Centurions.
For six hours April 27 at Kino Sports Complex, Tucsonans will have the chance to relive the "Three Days of Peace and Music" that transformed American life and culture at an upstate New York dairy farm 50 years ago.

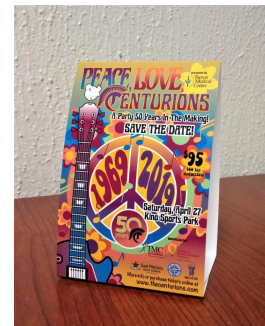

Reminder: 'New' Invoicing Process!

To ensure an effective invoicing and collection system, we're going back to strictly adhering to the process specified in our Bylaws for The New Centurions (Section 2.6):

- **30 days - ALL financial obligations are due in full within 30 days of the invoice; this includes ALL dues, event fees, and Event ticket & sponsorship sales revenue.**
- **60 days - ALL members with an invoice 60 days past due will be ineligible to attend ANY social event; e.g., Membership meetings, social events, Dinner Dance, etc.**
- **90 days - If a member's invoice reaches 90 days past due their membership will be automatically terminated.**

Please keep in mind that this process is automatic, as required by our Bylaws.
