Reminder: Charity Nominations Due by July 19

It's time again to decide which charities we wish to support in 2020. The support we're considering is for one year and up to \$100,000. The deadline for nominating a charity is Friday, July 19.

The process starts with nominations from Members. We ask that you keep our mission statement in mind when deciding to submit a charity:

"Our mission is to support Southern Arizona charities that provide services to underserved community members in the areas of healthcare, education, and mentorship, with an emphasis on improving children's lives"

The Charity Nomination 2020 form--located on the Member online portal under "<u>Downloads</u>"--must be submitted <u>anonymously</u> to Cindi at <u>cindi.ward@thecenturions.com</u>.

The Charity Selection Committee will review the submitted charities and establish a short list. The short-listed charities will then be notified that they are under consideration and will be asked to submit a detailed application.

Membership Committee Update: Rookie Candidates

Thanks to all who submitted nominations! We have 13 outstanding candidates for nine open Membership spots.

Led by Dave Couture, the Membership Committee is now beginning the vetting process. The group will narrow the nominee pool down to eight Rookie candidates for the Board's and Membership's approval. Patrick Burnham, who started as a Rookie this year, is expected to return next year as 2020 Rookie.

Reminder: Bylaws Provisions for Late Payments

Please keep in mind that this process is <u>automatic</u>, as required by our Bylaws:

- ALL invoices are due in 1-30 days. <u>ALL</u> financial obligations are due in full within 30 days of the invoice; this includes ALL dues, event fees, and Event ticket & sponsorship sales revenue.
- 60 days past due Membership Suspended. ALL members with an invoice 60 days past due will be ineligible to attend ANY social event; e.g., Membership meetings, social events, Dinner Dance, etc.
- **90 days past due Membership Terminated.** If a member's invoice reaches 90 days past due their membership will be automatically terminated.

All invoices now include a reminder of these provisions. Payments for both Membership and Event invoices may now be made online.
