#### **Social Events Updates**

Originally sent by email to all Members on May 7:

The planning team of Adam Dellos and Ben Ladrido had been working towards rescheduling our Steak Fry to May 30. However, based on

guidance received recently from the Governor's Office, restrictions on gatherings of more than 10 people will remain through at least the end of this month.

We're closely monitoring the situation and the Board will be considering options for rescheduling the Steak Fry for June or July if possible, including potentially using Westward Look's indoor venues.

Likewise, we're also looking to reschedule our Family Picnic, which was scheduled for May 30, for sometime this summer if possible.

#### **CARES Act PPP Loan Received**

Taking advantage of the COVID relief programs, we applied for and received a CARES Act PPP loan in the full amount for which we're eligible, \$28,195. The loan provisions will be forgiven for those funds spent on utility and payroll-related expenses by June 26, and will be essentially converted to a grant.

We also have submitted additional grant applications and had discussions with the Community Foundation Campus leadership on options for rent relief. The Campus has offered rent deferment options and is looking to be flexible in accommodating us.
