# Our 2020 Charities at Work in This Time of COVID-19

Bryan Hannley and Chris Hanson recently caught up with the leadership of our 2020 beneficiaries to see how they're weathering the current challenges and its affect on the youth they serve.

Adjusting to face these challenges, they've been innovative and largely moved to delivering their services online wherever possible. Fortunately, all are relatively financially stable and have not reduced staff or eliminated programs. One actually is hiring for new positions.

But of greatest concern across <u>each</u> of our charities--and across our community--is that our most vulnerable at-risk children are falling through the cracks. Losing inperson and on-site services, many children have dropped off the charities' radar. These largely 'unseen' children are subject to abuse, neglect, and worse.

In moving their programs online, Parent Aid greatly increased the number of classes they are able to conduct and families reached. This comes at a cost, though, since they lose the in-person visits to evaluate home and child welfare situations.

In addition to ongoing financial support, their needs include affordable technical website and IT support. Moving all programs has created a strain on their

resources.
