SOCIAL EVENTS

The Membership Board unanimously adopted the following criteria in order to hold our next social event as soon and safely as possible:

- General Criteria—The decision to hold a social event will depend on Pima County reporting COVID-19 Disease Data as having "Criteria Met" (web site: https://webcms.pima.gov/cms/One.aspx?portalld=169&pageId=568644), and/or reviewing CDC or State of Arizona guidance on large social gatherings to determine when it is safe and prudent to do so.
- Release/Waiver—Require that Members sign a release/waiver form before

attending any social event. This will be distributed to everyone within the next few days.

• Holiday Party—We'll base the decision on holding the Holiday Party if the above criteria are met, local restrictions on group size are lifted, and we're able to accommodate all Members and their guests in a safe and responsible manner. The Board will evaluate options and decide on the Holiday Party by October 15.
