We are still adhering to CDC and Pima county guidelines and have been monitoring all COVID related data for Pima County. The Membership Board and the Event Board put together a tentative plan for the next couple of months.

The Membership Board with Social Chairman Kevin Bedient put together a plan for the next couple of months that would include an **April Membership Meeting** and a **May Steak Fry** or similar, with monthly meetings happening up until our Event in October: *Rock the 80's, A Big Hair Affair.*

The Membership Board, in consultation with the other two Boards have established guidelines for participation in our monthly meetings for the foreseeable future. These are based on local government and CDC requirements for air travel.

All attendees will have to have a signed <u>Centurions COVID Release/Waiver</u> on file (attached) PLUS written proof of one of the following:

- Be fully vaccinated (both doses for Pfizer and Moderna vaccines), OR
- Have had a negative COVID test within 72 hours before the social event, OR
- Have had COVID within the last 90 days prior to the event with a doctor's note verifying the diagnosis.

Dues Update from The Membership Board

As you are aware, the Board decided to keep the dues level the same through 2021 for now and we're looking to resume our social events beginning next month (April), as noted above.

Our Membership dues pays for the direct costs for our social events: food, beverages, and venue. The Event, through a separate accounting system, pays for ALL built-in operating costs for BOTH the Event AND Membership. The Membership in turn "pays" for it's share of the operating costs (office, staff support, accounting & invoicing, etc.) by supplying the manpower for the annual Event.

Since we have not had an Event in 2020 and it's pending for later this year, we've been drawing from the Event's reserve account to cover our operating costs and the Membership has not been able to provide its share of manpower service. As a result, the Membership Board out of the need for fiscal responsibility has decided to keep the dues at the same level for now in the case it may be needed to supplement our operating costs, and also to fund additional or enhanced social events as we move out of the pandemic.

COVID Vaccine Info Updates



Here are some current updates and info on registering for a COVID-19 Vaccination. The sooner we get vaccinated, the sooner we'll be able to plan social events without restrictions. This is changing almost daily, so please check for latest updates:

State

Call 602-542-1000 (recommended) or register through https://podvaccine.azdhs.gov/.

Starting on March 24, Arizona has opened COVID-19 vaccine eligibility to all residents 16 and older.

Pima County

Call 520.222.0119 to schedule your shot.

Starting today, Thursday March 25 at 9AM, Pima County is expanding COVID-19 vaccine eligibility based on three criteria:

- 1. AGE--Anyone over age 55, regardless of health conditions or employment.
- RISK--Anyone over age 16 who has a high-risk medical condition as defined by CDC, or has a disability, or lives in a congregate setting or receives in-home longterm care.
- 3. **WORK**--Anyone over age 16 who works in one of the designated fields, regardless of health conditions.
